

**CT UROGRAM PANEL**

Your physician has requested a CT scan of the Urinary System. You will be positioned on the CT table on your back. The table will move into a donut like structure which contains the x-ray tube. The measurement is fed into a computer which produces a visual image of each “slice” of information. The images are monitored on a video screen during the exam and later photographed for the radiologist to study.

**PREP**

- No oral contrast (Barium)
- Drink clear liquids 8 hours prior to exam only
- Drink two 12 oz. glasses of water at 45 minutes and 30 minutes prior to exam

Your CT scan will be examined by the Radiologist, a physician who specializes in medical diagnosis by x-ray. After interpretation by the Radiologist, a typed report will be sent to your physician within 2-3 days. Your physician will discuss the results with you.
